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Free Patterns

BABY BOW HEADBANDS

Difficulty: Easy



Materials Needed

- 1) Fabric for the bow and center tie. For the bow, I recommend a [1.5 in x 2] in piece with a [¾ in x 1.5] in piece for the tie ...less than a post-it note! :)
 - a. Suggestions: Choose fabric that will not fray when you cut it...so you don't need to stitch the edges! Examples: synthetic, faux leather (real leather), felt, textured weighty material, etc. Even ribbon can work! I find leather wears really well and holds it shape nicely.
- 2) Scissors
- 3) Needle and thread
- 4) Elastic. 14inches fits most.
- 5) Optional hack: lighter or match and tiny elastics or rubber bands

Instructions

- 1) Cut out pattern pieces and elastic
- 2) Pinch bow together, making two evenly spaced dips, and secure with tiny elastic
- 3) Wrap tie piece around center to secure, stitch to keep in place (turn under if desired).
- 4) Snip elastic
- 5) Take elastic, thread through the loop.
- 6) Optional: burn edges of elastic slightly to melt and keep from fraying.
- 7) Stitch elastic together so the circle lays perfectly FLAT. Aim for ¼ inch of overlay
- 8) Shimmy the stitched bit of elastic under the bow so it is hidden.
- 9) All done! See how easy that was?

NOTE: Even tiny bumps can leave dents on soft baby heads! Keep the back as flat and smooth as possible. If needed, add a little soft felt in the back to cover up and hard bits.
